

## **Challenge Events 2023: Terms and Conditions**

The Cardiff Epic Trail 10k (after 'the event') is being promoted by Cardiff City FC Foundation (after 'The Foundation'), as a way to raise funds for, and awareness of, the official charity of Cardiff City FC.

The Foundation is not responsible for organising The Event and takes no responsibility for injury, death, loss, illness, damage to participants or their friends/family of participants. You agree that you are in good health and able to take part in the event, and that you participate at your own risk having followed the requisite training. If you are in doubt about your fitness you agree to seek medical advice. The Foundation takes no responsibility for your taking part in the event.

You agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the event from the event organisers, and to abide by the rules and regulations of the race. To take a charity place in the event you will pay a non-refundable registration fee of to confirm your place. If you drop out of the event due to injury or any other reason, then your place is nontransferable to another year, unless at the discretion of the Foundation senior management by taking a charity place in the event, you pledge to raise £200 (not including Gift Aid), by 6 weeks after the event.

You must carry out your fundraising in line with the rules of the Fundraising Regulator as the Foundation is registered with the Fundraising Regulator and is also bound by these rules.

You must not carry out any fundraising activity that could bring the Foundation into disrepute or harm the reputation of the Foundation, and the Foundation has the right to ask you to cease fundraising at any time.
